Jill worked at Texas Instruments as a machinist for 22 years before retiring.

She always had activities for the children, no matter if it was a summer picnic, Sankt Hans Aften activities, the Christmas party, Barnelopet, or any other event. She provided games, crafts, singing, decorating the children's Christmas tree, and of course, St Nick. In 2002, Jill was elected as Vice President and in 2004, was elected as President, and ultimately was counselor. She served in the President's position through 2006 and was a very effective leader.
