Info for the month: *Restauration was a sloop built in 1801, in Hardanger, Norway. It became a symbol of Norwegian American immigration. On what is considered the first organized emigration from Norway to the United States, Restauration set sail from Stavanger on July 4, 1825, with 52 people aboard. The people who made this voyage, who are sometimes referred to as the "Sloopers", moved onward to their first settlements.
